Boeing Corporation is very interested in the approach you and **Information Research Corporation (IRC)** are proposing to develop a new class of VoIP security mechanisms that can be enforced and implemented not only within a private network boundary but also outside of those boundaries. Your Content-Centric Security (CCS) process in its general conceptualization enables content to become self-governing by placing security behavior and authentication controls into the content. This process assures that the security controls are never separated from the content as it traverses the networks, and even after the content has been released or archived. If your research is successful, your CCS technique can be applied to the networks being developed for the MDA program, SBINet, and the wireless networks being implemented in Iraq. This technology is therefore of great importance not only to MDA, but on a number of other on-going and future network development efforts that Boeing is pursuing.

Boeing is continually searching for new and innovative technologies that can be used to improve the performance of the networks incorporated in the systems that we provide to the U.S. Government.
